Grades K-6 Parent Training



Laura Berquist's consultant training for this year is being made available to families! Laura will be offering an overview class on Grades PreK-2 (including some suggested resources for PreK) and a three part class on Grades 3-6. These classes explain the MODG goals and methods in these levels, and principles of making changes. Some commonly asked questions from our families this past year have been incorporated. The PreK class will be up to 2 hours and will include time for questions. Questions should be submitted beforehand.

The three part class for grades 3-6 will include an overview of the MODG 3-5 program on the first day, an overview of the 6th grade program on the second day, along with time for Q & A. The third day will be a practicum involving the grading of work. (Materials will be provided.) These classes will require internet. The materials will be sent out a week prior to class. Although parents are encouraged to sign up for both parts of the Grade 3-6 classes, they can also enroll in just one class.

In the first, James Berquist guides parents through the key points of St. Thomas' articles in the selection from St. Thomas Aquinas' Summa Theologica used in Grade 12 Advanced American Government and Economics. In the 2 hour class on Catholic Doctrine, James will go through the difficult arguments for intellect and will. All materials provided. Parents of rising 12th Graders, as well as anyone interested in one of our most advanced courses, are encouraged to enroll.

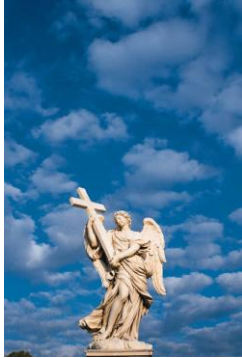

This class will use the materials listed in the MODG syllabus, and is open to students in grades 9-12. Students will receive 0.5 credits for this course. The MODG Health course uses the encyclical *Casti Connubii* supplemented with the Catechism of the Catholic Church. This course provides the student with an excellent overview of the Catholic moral teaching on marriage, sexuality, and family life. *Requires phone use.* This class will use the Catechism of the Catholic Church and the MODG Health syllabus (the entire text of the encyclical *Casti Connubi* is found in the MODG syllabus).
